- All rabbit exhibits must comply with the General Rules and Regulations as stated in this catalog. Rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association will be followed where applicable.
- Cage rent and feeding charge rabbits (per animal) \$1.00; Must be paid at the time of entry. No doe and litter.
- Feed & water containers will be provided.
- Exhibitors are limited to one (1) entry per class. Total entries may be limited due to the quantity of pens available.
- Substitution will be allowed only in the same class with an animal same breed and sex.
- Exhibitors will house their own animals under the supervision of the superintendent. Exhibitors must feed and water animals before leaving
- This show reserves the right to substitute another judge in the event that the first selection is unable to officiate
- All exhibits and each animal must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor. The superintendent may refuse any entry not deemed appropriate for the show. This rule will be strictly enforced.
- Decisions of the judge are final. Questions regarding judging decisions should be directed to the superintendent. Any exhibitor expressing disagreement with the judge will be disqualified and will forfeit any premiums won.
- Rabbits cannot be removed during the fair, except by order of the superintendent. Sick animals must be removed immediately
- 4-H and FFA members may enter the open show. Rabbits shown in 4-H or FFA may not be shown in the open show.
- Removal of Rabbits: During the Fair, no specimen can be removed, except by order of the superintendent.
- Release of Rabbits: Rabbits should be released after 10:00 p.m. Saturday night no later than 10:00 am. Sunday.

No premium will be paid to an exhibitor who removes any animal from its stall before release time on Sunday, Unless otherwise given permission from The St. Francois County Livestock Committee.
